

**ROAD AND BRIDGE COMMITTEE MINUTES  
CLAY COUNTY, ILLINOIS  
May 4th, 2022**

The Road and Bridge Committee met at 8:00 A.M. on Wednesday, May 4th, 2022 in the office of the Clay County Engineer, 14464 Highway 45 South, Louisville, Illinois.

The meeting was called to order by Joe Goodman who presided throughout. Also present was Committee Members, Joe Gilliland, Jeremy Kohn, County Engineer Darin Koelm, and Lee Ann Stanford, County Highway Department Secretary.

The Committee reviewed unpaid claims of the County Highway Department totaling \$105.00 and paid claims in the amount of \$51,269.90 the Committee members unanimously approved for County Engineer Darin Koelm with Secretary Lee Ann Stanford to present claims to the Claims Committee of these amounts.

Action items: Presentation and Approval of Bridge Aid Petition 22(02-02) Acts Lane in Blair Township was approved and will be presented to the County Board for approval.

Presentation and Approval of Bridge Aid petition 22(12-01) Honey Locust Lane in Xenia Township and will be presented to the County Board for approval.

Engineer's Report:

The CPR/AED class was successful. Held at the Flora Fire Department, 22 people were in attendance from the City of Flora, Clay County Courthouse and Clay County Highway Department.

TORMA will be hosting a Road Commissioner's Educational meeting including Supervisors from counties surrounding Clay. This will be in the evening possibly in July or August. Topics will include liabilities, signage, and expectations.

Summer help via CO-OP was approved. A student will be hired with no more than 999 hrs. to perform duties for the Highway Department such as mowing, housekeeping of vehicles and possible office duties.

The New Era Energy solar project in the Raccoon Creek area is approx. 80% complete as far as the planning stages.

There were no Public Comments as no visitors were present.

Next Road and Bridge Committee meeting will be Wednesday June 1st, 2022, at 8:00 a.m. There being no further business to come before the committee, upon motion duly made, and seconded and unanimously approved, the meeting was adjourned.
